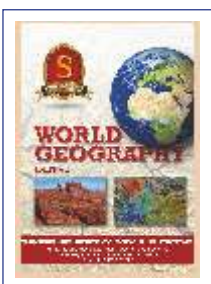
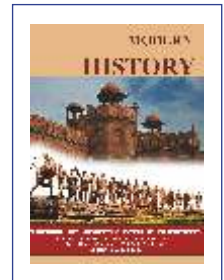


Medieval India

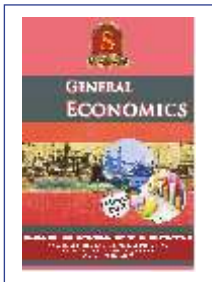

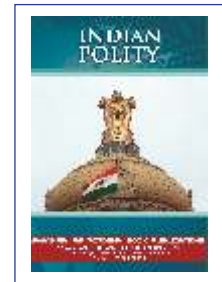


Economics - Part II

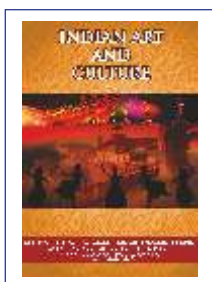
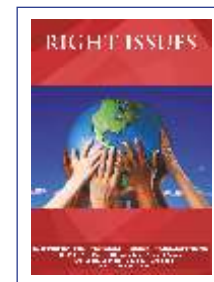
Environment

Rights Issue is based in the contemporary issues where in the overall weightage for preliminary and mains examination is less and the questions are of medium depth to high depth.

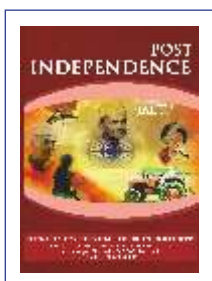
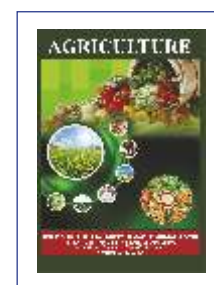


Art & Culture

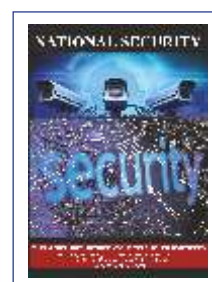
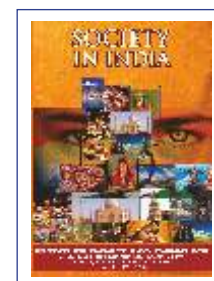


Post Independence Consolidation

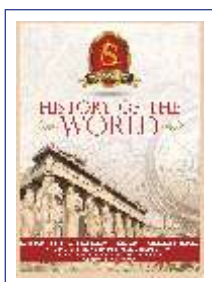
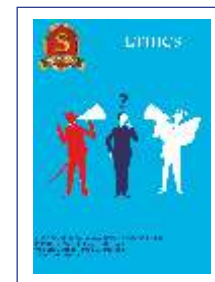
Internal Security

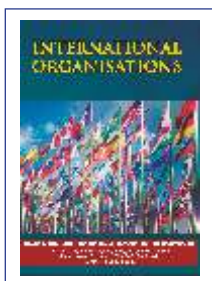


World History

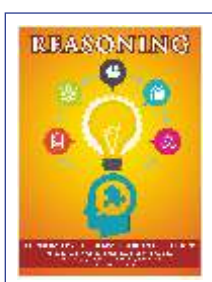


International Organization

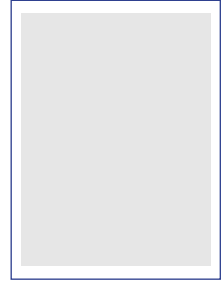
